<p>Response</p>	<p><i>Dear Sirs,</i></p> <p><i>We acknowledge your request for information under the Freedom of Information Scotland Act (FOISA), made on 25th June 2024 where you requested information relating to a property owned by The Riverside Group.</i></p> <p><i>As you will be aware disclosure of information held by a public authority under the FOISA is deemed to be a disclosure to the world at large for the purposes of the public interest.</i></p> <p><i>We confirm we do hold information relating to your request.</i></p> <p><i>However, we believe the information if disclosed under the FOISA would lead to living individuals being identified - which the FOISA does not permit. To do so would be a breach of the Data Protection Act 2018/UK GDPR.</i></p> <p><i>In view of the above, we therefore exercise a ‘Section 38 (1)(b) – Personal Information’ exemption under the FOISA against disclosure at this time.</i></p> <p><i>If you are dissatisfied with the handling of your request, you have the right to ask for an internal review.
